Specific Instructions

Article I Name

The business trust's name may *not* include any of the following words, phrases.

- Trust company
- Corporation
- Professional corporation
- Incorporated
- Limited company
- Limited liability company
- Professional limited liability company
- Limited partnership
- Registered limited liability partnership
- Limited liability partnership
- Registered limited liability limited partnership
- · Limited liability limited partnership

The business trust's name may *not* include the abbreviations, "Corp.," "Inc.," "L.C.," "LC," "L.L.C.," "LLC," "P.C.," "PC," "P.L.C.," "PLC," "P.L.P.," "LP," "LP," "R.L.L.P.," "RLLP," "LL.P.," "LL.P.," "LL.P.," "LLLP," "Code of which is prohibited by law for the business trust. See § 13.1-1214 of the Code of Virginia.

The proposed name must be distinguishable from other entity names on record with the Commission. To check the availability of a proposed name, visit https://cis.scc.virginia.gov

Article II Registered Agent

The registered agent's sole duty is to accept legal documents and notices on behalf of the company. The business trust may not serve as its own registered agent. The registered agent must be an individual or entity that meets one of the qualifications. Check the applicable box.

Article III Registered Office

The registered office location must be identical to the registered agent's business office.

- Only use a rural route and box number if the registered office's location has no street address.
- Only use a post office box if (i) there is no street address or rural route and box number, or (ii) the town/city has a population of 2,000 or less.

Provide the name of the county <u>or</u> independent city where the registered office is physically located.

Article IV Principal Office

The principal office is the location at which a beneficial owner may inspect the business trust's governing instrument as well as other information and records specified in Section 13.1-1278 E of the Code of Virginia.

The articles must set forth the address at which the principal office is physically located, which is to include a street and number, city or town, state and zip code. A rural route and box number may only be used if no street address is associated with the principal office's location. A post office box is not acceptable since it is not a location at which business records can be inspected.

Signature(s) of Organizers

The articles must be signed by the person(s) forming the trust. It is a Class 1 misdemeanor for any person to sign a document he or she knows is false in any material respect with intent that the document be delivered to the Commission for filing.

Important Information

The articles must be in the English language, typewritten or printed in black, legible and reproducible. The document must be presented on uniformly white, opaque paper, free of any visible watermarks and background logos.

Do not include personally identifiable information, such as a Social Security number, in a business entity document submitted to the Office of the Clerk for filing with the Commission.
